Note: Proper review of Zoning Permit Application takes time. Accordingly, please allow up to five business days for your application to be reviewed by Village staff.

New accessory buildings may require a building permit. These permits are issued by Professional Code Inspectors, Inc. (PCI), located in Hastings, MI. PCI will not issue a building permit before a completed and approved Zoning Permit Application from the Village of Middleville is received for the project.
