Yard Waste Collection

Last day for biodegradable paper yard waste bags pickup will be **October 8, 2018**. After this date, the DPW crew will begin vacuuming all the leaves and yard waste that is normally put in biodegradable bags.

Friendly reminders

Winter is coming! Please be aware that **Sec. 66-123 (a & b)** of our Code of Ordinances stipulates "(a) No vehicle shall be parked on any street in the Village between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.; (b) Except as otherwise provided by section 66-123(c), no vehicle shall be parked in any village-owned or operated parking lot between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m."

Also remember that recycling and garbage containers should be put behind the curb line or off the roads.

These would help our Department of Public Works crew to clear the snow of the streets properly.

It is time to Shake Your Mailbox!



Over time mailboxes deteriorate, the post are damaged, the wood, if they are mounted on a wood post, begins to rot and deteriorate.
