Water Charges

Commodity Charge: The commodity charge is 2.08 per thousand gallons used.

(All water customers not located within the Village Boundaries will be charged at rates equal to two times those rates paid by customers within the Village boundaries.)

Commodity Charge: The commodity charge is \$3.16 per thousand gallons used.

(All sewer customers not located within the Village Boundaries will be charged at rates equal to two times those rates paid by customers within the Village boundaries.)

For clarification purposes, **Commodity** means amount of water used per customer. **Readiness** is the "ready to serve" recurring charge billed quarterly based on the size of meter that services your property. Readiness means the water system can provide water at any moment. It is in place for the system capacity that is on standby for emergency purposes and operational flexibility. This charge applies even if you used no water during the billing period. **Debt** fees support debt payments on the common infrastructure (lift stations, main lines, water towers, transmissions) needed to accommodate existing sewage needs and the delivery of water to homes. This charge applies even if you had no usage during the billing period.
