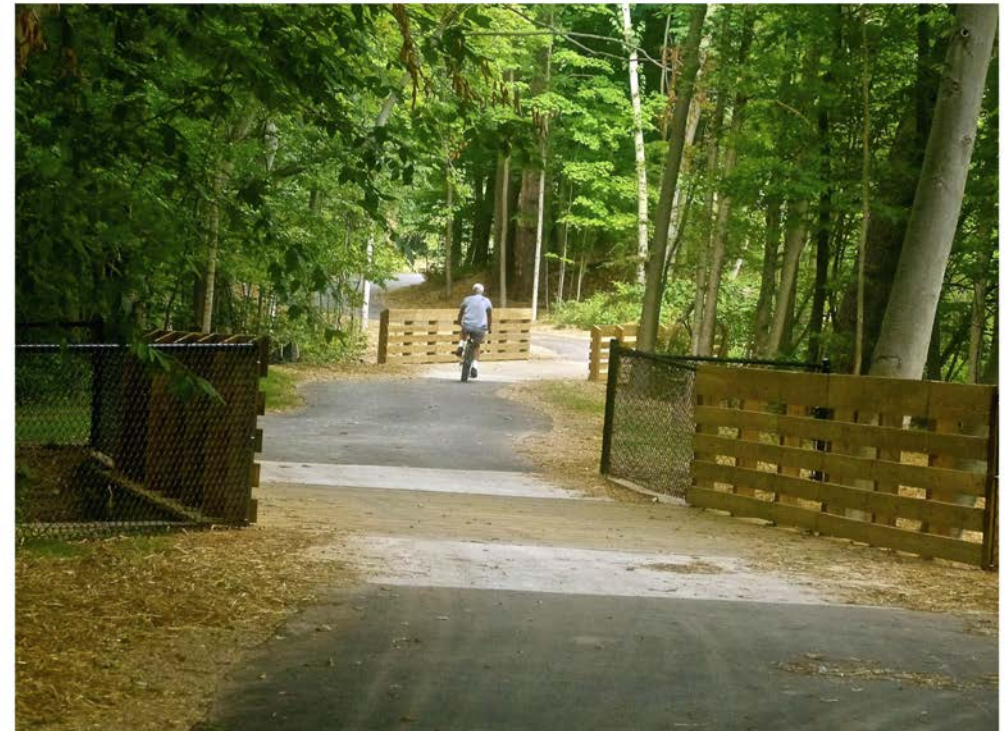
# Trails

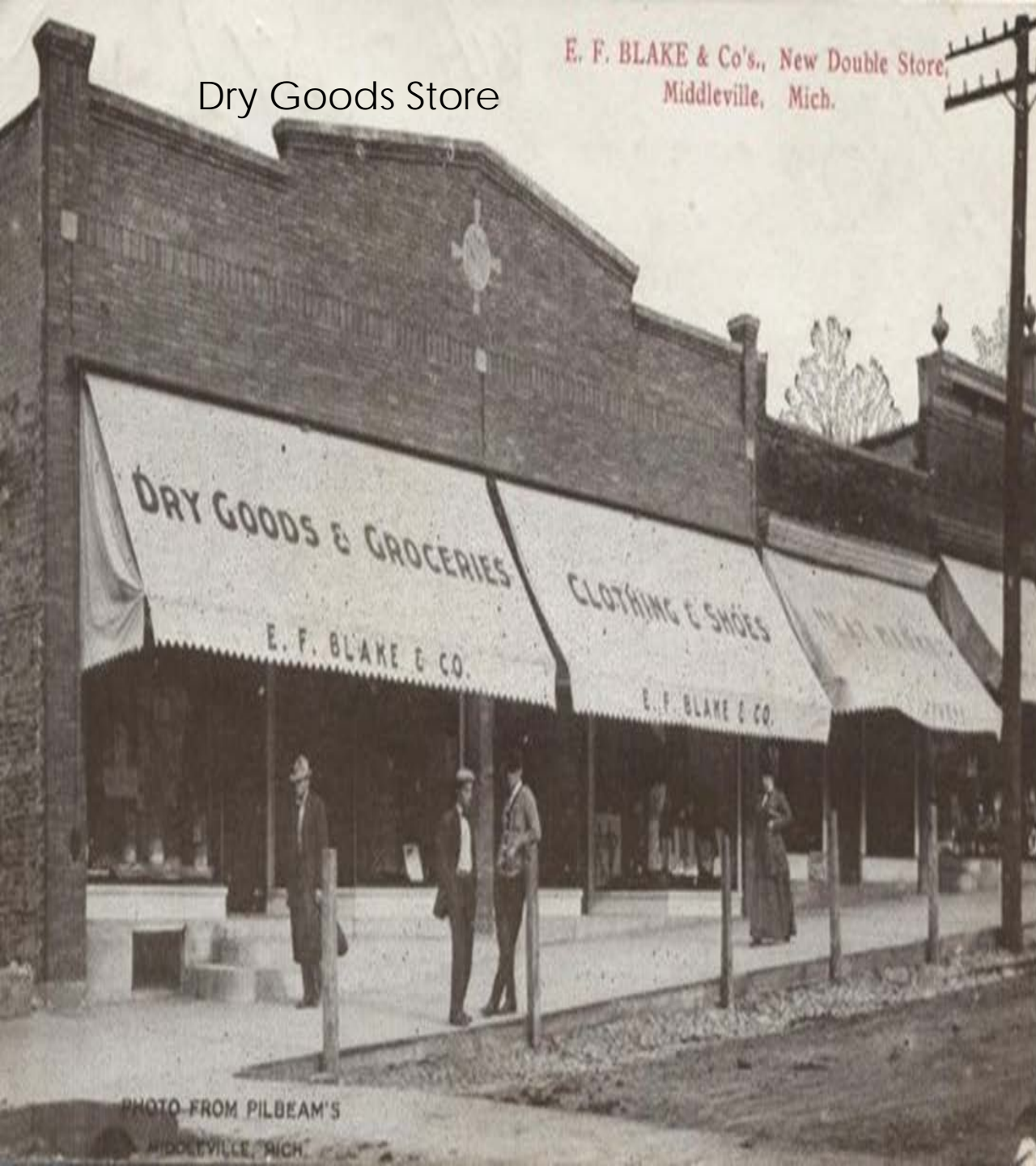
