



Annual Spring Cleanup

March 23, 2024

Annual Spring Cleanup Day is drawing near! As a service to residents, the Village of Middleville has arranged with Republic Services for a special pick-up day of household items, rolled carpet, furniture, and other large and bulky objects that have outlived their usefulness. See the list below for more information. **The annual cleanup will be on Saturday, March 23, 2024. You may start to place items at the curb beginning Saturday, March 16, 2024.**

All items must be placed at the curb by 9 pm the day before the pick-up as the private hauler will make one sweep beginning at 6 am.

The annual Spring Cleanup Day is a courtesy service provided for Village residents and property owners. This service does not extend to apartment complexes, condominiums, or mobile home parks. Any Village resident allowing Spring Cleanup items from outside the Village will forfeit their pick-up. If unauthorized waste items are included in with authorized waste items, the result will be that no items will be collected from that residence.

If items are placed out at the curb **after** the waste hauler has made the scheduled one sweep of the Village, the resident will be responsible for disposing of those items and any expense related to that disposal.

Acceptable Items:

- Furniture, toys, bicycles, appliances that do not contain Freon, home fixtures and any other items if they are considered non-hazardous.
- Mattresses - must be wrapped in plastic.
- Small amounts of building materials – door, window cabinet – must be cut down to fit into the truck and be lifted by one person. **NO DEMOLITION/REMODEL STYLE LARGE VOLUMES.**

Unacceptable Items:

- Small items that will fit in your garbage can.
- Kitchen refuse.
- Large plastic drums, concrete, large pieces of metal, yard waste, liquid waste, hazardous waste.
- Whole tires and/or tires on rims.
- Non-latex paints and varnishes, motor oil, solvents, batteries.
- Regulated medical waste.
- Large car parts such as: engine blocks, car bodies, oversize hoods, and doors.
- Appliances that contain Freon such as: refrigerators and air conditioners. *

* These items can be accepted if the Freon has been removed AND the appliance is “tagged” by a licensed facility that the Freon has been removed.

Resources for Hazardous Waste and Building Material Disposal

Hazardous Waste may be taken to the Barry County Expo Center (Barry County Fairgrounds), 1350 N. M-37 Hwy, Hastings, MI 49058, on Saturday, May 18, 2024, and Saturday, September 7, 2024, from 9:00am – 1:00pm, sponsored by the Barry County Solid Waste Oversight Committee sponsors these events. Waste Building Materials and other non-hazardous waste items may be taken by residents at their own expense to Waste Management’s Hastings Landfill (269) 945-2260 ext. 2, 1899 N. M-43 Highway, Hastings, MI 49058 between the hours of 8am – 3:30pm, Monday–Friday. Visit <https://www.wmsolutions.com/locations/details/id/82> for more information. A minimum fee will be charged per Waste Management for a truck-sized load that is brought to their location. The South Kent County Landfill on 100th St. in Caledonia at (616) 877-4092 is another location for residents to take items. Call ahead for rates and hours of operation.
